

# GUESS MY JOB



## Items used to make this Project:

- CD-3455 "Job Jars" Job Assignment Bulletin Board Set
- CD-1708 Community Helpers Bulletin Board Set and package header card
- Carson-Dellosa 2" EZ Letters (any color)
- CD-4006 Handprints & Kids' Art Pop-Apart Border (Optional)
- CD-1246 Colorful Dots Scalloped Border (Optional)
- Jingle, instructions, and clues (see page 2)
- Shipping labels (2" x 4" size) and address labels (1" x 2" size)
- Large construction paper (12" x 18" size)
- Glue
- Large loose leaf book rings

**Directions:** (Note: You will not use the jars that say "Jars" or the Chemist and Farmer Helpers for this book) Copy jingle, instructions and clues onto labels. Book Cover: Trim the jars that say "Job" to fit the front of the book and glue on the bottom half of front cover. Using the EZ Letters, spell out "Guess My" and glue to front cover of book above the "Job" jars. Glue three pieces of the paper strip accents to the top of book cover for decoration. Inside Book Cover: Glue five paper strip accents and mini pictures of the Community Helpers (cut out of the header card from the bulletin board set) leaving room for the jingle and instructions. Inside Pages: Front of page: If desired, separate pop-apart border (you will only use the Art side), cut two strips for each page and glue one to the top and one to the bottom of the page. Glue one job jar and three paper strip accents on the page. Attach a word clue to each of the accents. Note: The rows of clues are in the following order: doctor, mail carrier, chef, firefighter, plumber, hairdresser, teacher, dentist, veterinarian, and police officer. Back of page: Cut two strips of the Colorful Dots Border for each page and glue one to the top and one to the bottom of the page. Glue the appropriate Community Helper and job label to match the clues from the front page. Repeat for all ten job jars. Laminate everything, center inside pages to folded cover before punching holes in cover. Punch holes and bind with loose leaf binder rings. After reading the clues and guessing the job, pause and discuss other things that this person does in his or her job.
