

# Counting Floor Game



## Items used to make this Project:

- CD-110006 Numbers 0–30: Kid-Drawn Bulletin Board Set
- Vinyl tablecloth
- Clear contact paper

**Directions:** Using contact paper, adhere each number to the smooth side of the tablecloth in random order. Place the tablecloth on the floor and prepare to play with 3 or 4 children at one time using one of the versions below.

**Versions: Addition:** The teacher or a student will serve as the caller. The caller will call out one number and the players will each have to pick two numbers that add up to that number. For example, the caller says number "25." The player chooses 20 + 5 for his two numbers that add up to 25. The player then must put one foot on one number and one hand on the other number. Once all 3 or 4 players have picked and twisted to their two numbers, untwist and play again. **Even/Odd:** The caller will call out "even" or "odd" and the players will have to alternate between their feet and hands to cover a number that matches. **Subtraction:** Same version as addition, only players must use subtraction to get the two numbers to equal the callers' number.
