1. Shaped Books

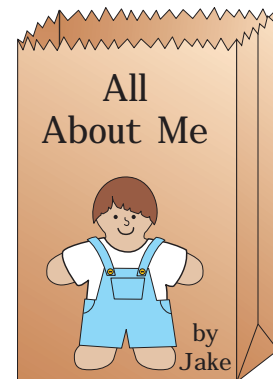
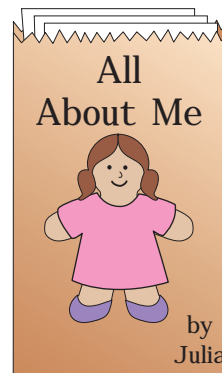


2. Story Bags

I have a pet cat and his name is Cheese.



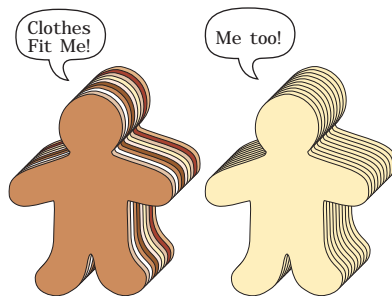

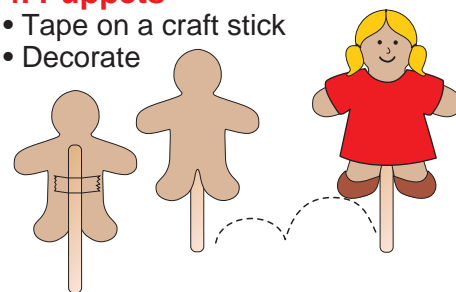
