### ★ Featured Display: Theme Books

Here's a hands-on way to interest students in different types of books. To create the large books, cut seven 12" x 18" cardboard rectangles and fold each in half. Cover the outside of each book with colored fadeless paper or solid wrapping paper. Glue construction paper to the inside of the book, covering the edges of the wrap. For each book's theme, attach one of the bulletin board set pieces to the cover. Finish by writing suggested book titles for age-appropriate reading in each of these books. Display these "books" in your reading center and encourage students to open them up to discover new reading suggestions. Kids delight in the way they can interact with this creative display!
