



Items used to make this Project:



- DJ-608005 Green Plaid Straight Border
- DJ-620021 Flowers Colorful Cut-Outs (Assorted Designs)
- CD-168014 Insects: Photographic Shape Stickers
- Construction paper
- Glue and tape
- Scissors



Directions: Lay construction paper horizontally on a flat surface. Cut the Green Plaid Straight Border to match the length of the bottom of the construction paper. Glue or tape it on. Choose a Flower Colorful Cut-Out to go with the piece of construction paper. Cut the stem from the flower at the base of the flower. Glue or tape the stem and leaves to the Green Plaid Straight Border. Tape the top only of the flower above the lower part of the flower so the two pieces match at the cut. Choose an insect sticker, lift the flower and stick it onto the construction paper. Make several of these sheets. Write a clue for guessing each insect and glue or tape it to the top of the construction paper above the flower. Make a title page with the words "Who Am I?" and glue or tape it down. Use several flowers and insects to decorate this page. Read the clue and see if you can guess the insect before lifting the flower to see if you're right.

Clues:

I have beautiful big wings and I begin my life as a caterpillar.

(Butterfly)

I am green or brown and I hop in the grass.
Who am I?
(Grasshopper)

I am round and red with black spots.
Who am I?
(Ladybug)

I am yellow and black I buzz when I fly.
Who am I?
(Bee)

I like picnics. I have six legs, but don't have any wings.
Who am I?
(Ant)
