

**Grade Level: K-3**  
**Subject: Language Arts/Letter Sounds; Art**

**Objective:**  
 Learn the shape and sound of each letter of the alphabet.

**Materials Needed:**

- TREND 4" Ready Letters® (any pack)
- Markers, crayons, or colored pencils
- Construction paper
- Glue or tape

**Directions:**

Punch out one of each letter of the alphabet to have them ready for use. Brainstorm with the group a list of animals that start with each letter of the alphabet.

1. Give each student a sheet of construction paper and one letter of his or her choice.
2. Think about how to create an animal using the letter as a part of the animal's body.
3. Glue or tape the letter to the construction paper and design the animal around the letter.
4. Incorporate the animal into a scene or habitat where one might find the animal.

Post the letter animal scenes in a row for all to see the animal alphabet line, or create a book with the alphabet animal art.
