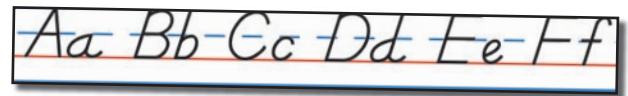


# Learning Stick Activity



## Items used to make this Project:

- Large paint sticks (can be picked up at local hardware stores)
- CD-4404 Traditional Manuscript Alphabet Desk Tape, or
- CD-4405 Modern Manuscript Alphabet Desk Tape
- Clothespins



**Directions:** Apply the alphabet desk tape to the paint stick and attach one clothespin. The teacher will read a question or clue that can be answered by placing the clothespin over the correct letter. For example, "I am the letter that ends the word sun." The student would respond by placing the clothespin over the letter "n" on the learning stick. Carson-Dellosa Colorful Cut-Outs make great clue cards for this learning game.

Other examples of clues include:  
 I am the letter that ends the word blue.  
 I am the letter that begins your name.  
 I am the letter that begins the word cat.
